

**Sweet Dream's Lamp**- "functional South West Art"  
with Sherry Hunga-Moore

If you are a beginner or even an expert you will enjoy this class. This class is planned so you will finish within 5 hours. We will break 1 hour for lunch.

I will demonstrate each step so you will be able to create a unique Southwest Lamp. It is a perfect decorative accent, night light or gift for someone special.



-Demonstrate how to:

- Prepare bottom of gourd and attach it to the platform
- Cut holes in front for Dream Catcher and rear for lamp using a Hole Saw and drill
- Quick and easy way to secure dream catcher to gourd
- Create feather array using feathers, leather and glue
- Wrap ring with leather, secure with glue
- Learn the Dream Catcher stitch (a finished one is provided also just in case...)
- How to attach your feather array with leather strips and a Concho
- Embellish with beads and a charm
- Install lamp

You may want to Woodburn a pattern or design on center band, if not the lamp looks lovely without it. We will seal project prior to attaching feathers.
